March 30 - May 5, 2009**

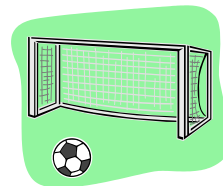

Dribbling

Passing

- *To move the ball from one player to another.*

Trapping

- *To stop the ball in motion*

Shooting

- *Kicking the ball toward the goal using the inside of the foot*

“No Hands”

- *Soccer is a “no hands” sport, except for the goalie*

Sportsmanship

- *Players working together and acknowledging good teamwork*
